ABOUT OUR COURSE

- The Beech Mountain Club's 18-hole, ridge-top golf course boasts magnificent views of mountain ranges in North Carolina, Tennessee and Virginia.
- Originally designed by Willard Byrd, the course has undergone a renovation over the last 10 years, extending the course to 6,250 yards in length.
- The course ranges over elevations between 4,200 and 4,700 feet, so the average summer temperature rarely exceeds 79 degrees.
- The golf course is open seven days a week from May through October.
- There are seasonal rates for members, in addition to daily fees for members and their guests.
- Access to the course is available for non-members through rental of qualified lodging.
- The Pro Shop offers clinics and private lessons along with a wide variety of clothing and equipment.
- There are several golf associations just waiting for you to join them. We have Men's, Ladies, Lady Niners Golf Assoc., and weekly Twilight Couples Golf tournament.
- The Club hosts a variety of tournaments and fund-raisers throughout the year.
